City Council Meeting Minutes January 8, 2018

The Regular Council meeting of the Douglas City Council was held on Monday, January 8, 2018, at $5:30~\rm p.m.$ in the Council Chambers of City Hall at $101~\rm N.$ $4^{\rm th}$ Street, Douglas, Wyoming.

<u>CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/ROLL CALL</u>: Mayor Jones called the meeting to order and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call the following were present:

<u>Disclosures by City Councilmembers</u>: Mayor Jones asked for disclosures of any conflicts of interest for Council members; there were none.

Consent Agenda: Councilmember Bartling moved to approve the Consent Agenda as presented: Item 2.I. Corrections, Additions, Approval of Agenda for January 8, 2018; Item Consideration of Resolutions and Ordinance by Title Only; Item 2.III. Warrant Register, December 2017; Item 2.IV. Minutes, Regular City Council Meeting, December 11, 2017; Item 2.V. Minutes, Special Council Meeting, December 12, 2017; Item 2.VI. Minutes, Special Council Meeting, December 13, 2017; Item 2.VII. Special Council Meeting, December 26, 2017; 2.VIII. Minutes, Special Council Meeting, January 3, 2018; 2.IX. Minutes, Special Council Meeting, January 4, 2018; 2.X. Converse County Joint Justice Center, Ratification of Century Link Installation of Copper Lines. Councilmember Kemper Amendment, seconded; no discussion and motion approved 5-0.

<u>Public Comments:</u> Jacquelyn Pollock approached Council with questions about her dismissal from the Converse County Tourism Board as a City appointment. Mayor Jones explained that the discussion occurring in executive session could not be shared publicly.

Application for Special Permits/Appointments to Boards and Commissions: Item 4.I. E-911 Joint Powers Board, 2018 City Councilmember Appointments: Councilmember Bartling moved to move

to appoint Leroy Kingery and Rene Kemper to the Joint Powers Board as voting members from Jan. 20, 2018, to Dec. 31, 2018; Councilmember Kemper seconded; no discussion and motion approved 5-0. Councilmember Kemper moved to appoint John Bartling as the alternate voting member from Jan. 20, 2018, to Dec. 31, 2018; seconded by Councilmember Gilbreath; no discussion and motion approved 5-0. Item 4.II. Wyoming Community Gas Board, 2018 City Councilmember Appointments: Councilmember Bartling moved appoint Monty Gilbreath to the Wyoming Community Gas Board from Jan. 8, 2018 to Dec. 31, 2018; seconded by Councilmember Kemper; no discussion and motion approved 5-0. Councilmember Kemper moved to appoint Leroy Kingery to the Wyoming Community Gas 8, 2018 to Dec. 31, 2018; Councilmember from Jan. Gilbreath seconded; no discussion and motion approved 5-0.

Council Items: Item 5.1. Ordinance 993, Revising Title 12 of Douglas Municipal Code Regarding the Repair and Maintenance of Certain Public Property: Councilmember Kingey moved to approve 993 as presented on first reading; Ordinance seconded а Councilmember Gilbreath. Discussion of proposed followed, which will be presented at second reading. No further discussion and motion approved 5-0. Item 5.II. Ordinance 994 Amending Chapter 13.10.010 of the Douglas Municipal Clarifying the Requirements for Separate Water Connections for Individual Residences and Property Owners: Councilmember Kemper moved to approve Ordinance 994 as presented on first reading; seconded by Councilmember Kingery. Following discussion, motion approved 5-0. Item 5.III. Bid Recommendation, New 2018 Specified Utility Maintenance Distribution Pickup, and Department: Councilmember Bartling moved to reject all bids and re-advertise the vehicle as recommended; Councilmember Kingery seconded. Director Harbarger explained why all bids were recommended to be rejected, which is due to a change in the specifications which not all bidders were aware of; this recommendation is in the interest of ensuring equity in the bidding process. No further discussion and motion approved 5-0. Item 5.IV. Converse County Joint Justice Center: i. Bid Recommendation, Instrumentation Technology Services Agreement: Councilmember Kemper moved award both the bid for network hardware services in the amount of \$106,694.04, and the bid for server storage hardware in the amount of \$84,505.20, to Ptolemy Data Systems, for a total amount of \$191,199.24, and further authorize the interim city administrator to sign all associated documentation; seconded by Councilmember Bartling. Following discussion, motion approved 5-0. ii. Change Order Request No. 113, Time Extension and General Conditions: Councilmember Gilbreath moved to approve COR #113 as presented and authorize the time extension for substantial completion of 45 days (February 22, 2018), and further authorize

payment of the City's proportionate share in the amount of \$8,840.00. Following lengthy discussion, including explanations for the needed extension by both Hal Hutchinson, Owner's Representative, and city staff, motion approved 4 - 1Councilmember Kingery opposing the motion. iii. Potential Amendment, Century Link, Special Construction Proposal: Councilmember Kemper moved to approve the potential amendment Century Link; Councilmember Kingery seconded. discussion followed, including Council's feeling that this cost should not be added on due to previous conversations and delays that are not the fault of the owners; the need to not delay and keep this project moving; and potential scheduling delays if not approved. No further discussion and motion approved 3-2 with Councilmembers Kingery and Gilbreath opposing the motion. Item Contract, City Attorney Services, Between the City Douglas and Heather Duncan-Malone: Councilmember Kemper moved to approve the contract for City Attorney services as presented; seconded by Councilmember Gilbreath; no discussion and motion approved 5-0. Interim Administrator Rimmer officially swore in Ms. Duncan-Malone as the City Attorney. Everyone thanked Eric Nelson for his years of service and help during his tenure.
