

1 **Work Session, Douglas City Council**

4 A Work Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Thursday, January 23, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.
5 in the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming. Those present were:

11 **Item 1.I. Overview of History of Douglas Transfer Station/Landfill:** Alan Gorrell provided
12 Council with an overall history of the landfill and transfer station, including reasons for
13 choosing a transfer station versus a regional landfill; current and historic waste stream
14 data; current and historic uses of all 120 acres of the landfill; processes and costs of the
15 Casper Regional Landfill; other permitted uses of the Douglas landfill; items currently being
16 recycled; potential future options for recycling other materials; and other regional landfills
17 in Wyoming and northeastern Colorado. **Item 1.II. Review of Council Agenda:** Administrator
18 Teichert provided an overview of the Council agenda for the regular meeting to be held on
19 January 27, 2020. Items discussed at length included Resolution 2023 for a short-term rental;
20 bulk fuel bid specifications; and the Boys & Girls Club application for funding. There were no
21 revisions to the agenda items. **Item 1.III. Boards and Commissions: Council Member Updates:**
22 Council members reported to each other on the Converse County Joint Justice Center Joint
23 Powers Board and the Municipal and County Joint Powers Board; there were no other board
24 meetings to discuss at this time. **Item 1.IV. City Administrator Weekly Update:** Administrator
25 Teichert updated Council on preparations for the 2020 Census; status and revisions to the
26 final draft of the Converse County EIS; the potential trail track system, including alternate
27 routes and ways to move forward; multiple upcoming projects including the Waste Water
28 Treatment Plant, the Level II Water Study, and improvements to a pond near Keith Rider Park;
29 and Police open employment position updates. No further discussion and the Work Session was
30 adjourned at 5:40 p.m. **No Council action was taken.**
