

**Work Session, Douglas City Council
February 6, 2020**

A Work Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Thursday, February 6, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming. Those present were:

Item 1.a. Welcome Home Wyoming Draft Resolution: Greg Hancock, Cheyenne Housing Authority provided Council with an overview of the program and why they are requesting the resolution.

Item 1.b. Municipal Pool Agreement 2020: Administrator Teichert reviewed changes made to the agreement. Councilman Gilbreath reviewed the advantages of this agreement and differences of wages. Jamie Pinkerton answered questions from Council regarding the Chlorine controls and responsibility of water quality.

Item I.c. ACT Workforce Ready Communities: Administrator Teichert advised the Commissioners are interviewing a candidate at this time for this position and they are asking communities to pitch in for this program. Discussion of the program and questions would want answered.
