

1 **Work Session, Douglas City Council**

2 **May 7, 2020**

3 A Work Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Thursday, May 7, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. in  
4 the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Douglas, Wyoming, with applicants and members of the  
5 public attending virtually via voice or video call. Mayor Kemper called the meeting to order.

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13 Mayor Kemper stated for the record that the City Council members present were only present to  
14 listen to the discussion and would be holding presentations at a later date for the Community  
15 Service Grant applications made to the City. Discussion was held with applicants requesting  
16 Community Service Grant funding for FY2021 with the following non-profit organizations; the  
17 amount of each request from the City and County respectively are included: Boys & Girls Club -  
18 Douglas (\$50,000/\$50,000); Children's Advocacy Project (\$4,000/\$5,000); Converse Hope Center  
19 (\$400,000/\$100,000); Douglas Community Club (\$75,000/\$30,000); Douglas Youth Hockey  
20 (\$24,000/\$30,000); The Enterprise (\$85,000/\$119,460); Human Resource Council - Community  
21 Service Block Grant (\$14,000/\$14,000); Laramie Peak Humane Society (\$100,000 plus \$5,000 for  
22 spay and neuter programs/\$15,000 plus facility); Solutions for Life (\$40,000/\$75,000); Wyoming  
23 Child and Family Development (\$5,000/\$5,000); Youth Development Services (\$15,000/\$45,000).  
24 Organizations provided overviews of services, goals, projects, and reasons for amounts of  
25 requests. City Council members and County Commissioners asked questions of each organization  
26 based upon services and request amount; clarifications of specific items from some agencies  
27 were asked for. The Joint Study Session was adjourned at approximately 3:03 p.m. **No Council**  
28 **action was taken.**
