Presentations were made to Council members and Commissioners by applicants requesting Community Service Grant funding for FY2019 by the following non-profit organizations (including the amount of each request from the City and County respectively): The Enterprise (\$100,000/\$100,000); Converse County Aging Services D/B/A Douglas Senior (\$100,000/\$180,000 which included Glenrock center); Laramie Peak Humane Society (\$100,000 plus \$5,000 for spay and neuter programs/\$14,000 plus facility); Boys and Girls Club of Douglas (\$25,000/\$25,000); Children's Advocacy Project (\$2,000/\$5,000); Youth Development Services (\$10,000/\$40,000); Converse Hope Center (\$10,000/\$25,000 plus facility and utilities); Human Resource Council D/B/A Community Service Block Grant (\$5,000/\$5,000); Solutions for Life (\$20,000/\$40,000); Wyoming Child and Family Development (\$5,000/\$5,000); King's Portion (\$50,000/\$25,000); CCSD#1/Recreation Board D/B/A Douglas Rec Center (\$20,000/no request to County); Douglas Youth Hockey Association (\$20,000/included in County's Parks & Rec Budget); Helping Hands Ministries Inc. (\$6,150/no request to County); Here to Help Foundation of Wyoming (no specific amount requested and no request to County); and Douglas Community Club, Inc. (\$60,000/included in County's Parks & Rec budget). Council members and Commissioners asked questions of several agencies and requested additional documentation from some.
