

1 **Work Session, Douglas City Council**

3 A Work Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Thursday, May 7, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. in
4 the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming, with applicants and members of the
5 public attending virtually via voice or video call. Mayor Kemper called the meeting to order.

13 Presentations were made applicants requesting Community Service Grant funding for FY2021 by
14 the following non-profit organizations; the amount of each request listed: Boys & Girls Club -
15 Douglas (\$50,000); Children's Advocacy Project (\$4,000); Converse Hope Center (\$400,000);
16 Douglas Community Club (\$75,000); Douglas Youth Hockey (\$24,000); The Enterprise (\$85,000);
17 Human Resource Council - Community Service Block Grant (\$14,000); Laramie Peak Humane Society
18 (\$100,000 plus \$5,000 for spay and neuter programs); Solutions for Life (\$40,000); Wyoming
19 Child and Family Development (\$5,000); Youth Development Services (\$15,000). Organizations
20 provided overviews of services, goals, projects, and reasons for amounts of requests. City
21 Council members asked questions of each organization based upon services and request amount;
22 clarifications of specific items from some agencies were asked for. The Work Session was
23 adjourned at approximately 2:57 p.m. **No Council action was taken.**
