

Study Session, Douglas City Council
June 11, 2018

A Study Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Monday, June 11, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming. Mayor Jones called the meeting to order. Those present were:

Mayor and Council: Bruce A. Jones, Mayor; Councilmembers Leroy Kingery; John Bartling; Rene´ Kemper; and Monty Gilbreath

Others Present: Jonathan Teichert, City Administrator; Karen Rimmer, City Clerk; Mary Nicol, City Treasurer; Ron Casalenda, Chief of Police; Gary Schwarz, IT Director

Mary Nicol provided an overview of the investment options offered from Points West Bank, which are TDOAs only. Discussion then followed regarding the agreement with CMI (vendor) for Justice (software for Police Department). Chief Casalenda and Gary Schwarz provided an overview and answered questions for Council, including costs, level of service, history, and that none of the cloud services apply. This is an action item on the regular meeting agenda. Mayor and Council also discussed the Tri-State License Agreement and proposed amendments; Administrator Teichert provided an overview and history of this and stated that after speaking with the City Attorney, it is his recommendation to have the City Attorney draft a letter to address the agreement and proposed amendments. Council concurred; this is a tabled item on the regular meeting agenda. Following final questions, suggestions, and comments from Council, the Study Session was adjourned at 4:50 p.m. **No Council action was taken.**
