

Study Session, Douglas City Council
July 9, 2018

A Study Session of the Douglas City Council was held on Monday, July 9, 2018, at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 101 N. 4th Street, Douglas, Wyoming. Mayor Jones called the meeting to order. Those present were:

City Council and staff discussed potential changes to the lease agreement between the City of Douglas and The Enterprise, an action item on the regular meeting agenda. Following discussion, including input from Cindy Porter, Council concurred that they'd like to consider the lease as presented; any changes will be made during the meeting. Potential changes would be for the term of the lease from one year to three years. The Father Hubbard's Cupboard lease was also discussed as it pertains to a portion of the same building and will be considered by Council at the July 23, 2018 regular meeting. Council and staff also discussed the upcoming 2020 Census and creating a committee to educate the public with the importance of participating in and providing accurate data for the census. Projects and activity in our county was discussed at length, as was the stakeholders needed on the committee, including the City of Douglas, Converse County, Converse County School District #1, Memorial Hospital of Converse County, and The Enterprise. Following final questions and comments from Council, the Study Session was adjourned at 5:20 p.m. **No Council action was taken.**
