A. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Heidi McCullough at 5:24.

B. Approve Minutes of the August 19, 2020 meeting

Minutes from August 19, 2020 were reviewed, and it was moved by Bauman to approve, seconded by Evins motion passed 6-0.

C. Old Business:

1) Training Updates

- McCullough has watched one and Evins has looked at the SHPO one.

2) Pioneer Cemetery Update

- McCullough working on wordage for sign
- Plat done and ready to take to Council, but realized that subdivision was in County, so they could not go through with it
- Has to annex property into City limits
- May be January before issue can get moving again

3) South Douglas District Update

- Finished photography phase II
- Photographed 173 properties

- Think that there is a high percentage of contributing properties
 - Compiling Sanborn maps and compiling site records from assessor's office to trace physical evolution of neighborhood
- 4) Sir Barton Sign
- McCullough working on drawing up wordage

D. New Business:

- 1) CLG Grant 2021- due November 16, 2020
- Discussed doing a nomination for either South Douglas District or the Pioneer Cemetery to the National Register of Historic Places
 - Pelton recommended that the cemetery/Child's Trail might not be eligible
 - Pelton motioned to apply for CLG grant for South Douglas District, Bauman seconded. Passed 5-0.
