MINUTES January 19, 2022

1. Call to Order
 - a. Called to order at 5:29 pm by Commissioner McCullough
2. Approve Minutes of the November 17, 2021 meeting
 - a. Bauman moved to approve minutes, Varland seconded, unanimously approved
3. Old Business:
 - a. Newly appointed Commissioner Pickinpaugh was unable to attend but will be introduced at the next meeting. Currently the commission has the minimum 7 members, so 2 positions are still open if there are additional applicants.
 - b. Training Updates
 - i. McCullough attended an online webinar and will make sure the links are going out to the members not getting the emails directly.
 - c. Bozeman Trail
 - i. McCullough and Ian Lindeman from the Converse County Historical Society attended the City Council work session on November 18th to discuss in depth the issues they had. After answering questions regarding private property rights and oil and gas development implications, they agreed to support going forward with the feasibility study. At the City Council meeting on November 22, the resolution in support of a feasibility study to see if the Bozeman Trail qualifies for National Trail status was passed.
4. New Business
 - a. Budget requests are due earlier this year, they will need to be voted on during the February meeting. Ideas were: match for CLG grant for walking tour brochures, 3rd Grade workbook printing. Commissioners should bring ideas to the next meeting.
 - b. There has been a nomination submitted for the Old National Guard Armory on the Wyoming State Fairgrounds. As the local CLG we are invited to submit comments to the State Review Board. We are not required to comment. Comments need to be submitted to McCullough by January 24th and she will draft a letter.
