4 A Joint Work Session of the Douglas City Council and Converse County Commissioners was held on Monday, April 19, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the
5 Community Room of the Converse County Courthouse at 107 N. 5th Street, Douglas, Wyoming. Commissioner Willox called the meeting order at
6 approximately 9:00 a.m.

12 Discussion was held with the applicants requesting Community Service Grant funding for FY2022 with the following non-profit organization; the
13 amount of each request from the City and County respectively are included: CANDO D.B.A The Enterprise (\$85,000/\$119,460 plus \$64,000 for
14 ACT); Youth Development Services (\$15,000/\$45,000); Laramie Peak Humane Society (\$110,000 plus \$5,000 for spay and neuter
15 programs/\$15,000 plus the facility); Boys & Girls Club of Douglas (\$25,000/\$50,000); WY Child & Family Development (\$5,000/\$5,000);
16 Children’s Advocacy Project (\$4,000/\$4,000); Converse Hope Center (24,800/\$20,000 plus facility and utilities); Community Service Block Grant
17 through Human Resource Council (\$14,000/\$14,000); Solutions for Life (\$50,000/\$55,000); King’s Portion (\$52,400/\$0); Converse County School
18 District #1, Recreation Board (\$40,000/\$0); Douglas Community Club (\$75,000/\$30,000); Douglas Youth Hockey (\$24,000/\$30,000).
19 Organizations provided overviews of services, goals, projects, and reasons for amounts of requests. City Council members and County
20 Commissioners asked questions of each organization based upon services and request amount; clarifications of specific items from some
21 agencies was requested. The Joint Work Session adjourned at approximately 1:45 p.m. **No Council Action was taken.**
