## **Old Business-**

Training updates

- Julia Evins expressed interest in signing up for training opportunities offered by the National Alliance for Preservation Commission's online forum. Additional members registering will be Bauman, McCullough, and Siebken.

Flaherty update

- Discussed options besides plaques, including signed books and possible options from SHPO to be presented to Betsy Flaherty at an August City Council meeting in recognition of her years of service to the Commission.

Trail update

- City Parks hired a contractor to grade road into cemetery and the contractor disturbed portion of Child's Trail.
- Discussed possibility of locking the gate and putting a sign on it to arrange visits, which the Commission opposed on the basis of no history of vandalism at the site.
- Also discussed placing parking area that is fenced to prevent people from disturbing trail, with walking and driving gates provided for access.
- Work on establishing parcel as a City subdivision, zoning it green space, and establishing an overlay historic district will go to the Planning Commission and City Council in August.
- McCullough will contact Jason Vlcan to try and schedule another field trip to site

South Douglas District Update

- Sherri received a nice letter from the contractors updating on progress
- Requested that we get the word out about photographers being in their neighborhood

- Talking with SHPO about how to get site numbers
