Cover: The Lanier Mansion State Historic Site in Madison, Indiana was the home of financier James F. D. Lanier, whose loans to the state of Indiana enabled the state to equip Union troops during the Civil War. This Greek Revival mansion, completed in 1844, was designed by architect Francis Costigan and is designated a National Historic Landmark. After a major historical research project, the State of Indiana, which owns the site, called upon Porter to recreate the colors shown, based on the results of the research.
