

ORDINANCE NO. 1030

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.04.110 OF THE DOUGLAS MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, WYOMING, REGARDING CURB STOP INSTALLATION AND ACCESS

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas (City) Council finds and determines that the following changes need to be made in regarding accessibility of curb stops by city staff; and

WHEREAS, consideration has been given to ensure fairness to all City of Douglas residents and to make new regulations reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, WYOMING, that:

Section 1. Section 13.04.110 is revised to read as follows:

13.04.110 Curb Stops – Installation and Access.

- A. Curb stops shall be furnished and installed by a contractor licensed to work in the city for all structures to be served with water.
B. Single-family dwellings and businesses shall have curb stops installed within five (5) feet of the property line, at the back of the sidewalk if space allows; or within the sidewalk if the sidewalk abuts a building, set level with the sidewalk, and such curb stops shall be of a ferrous, metallic composition to allow for location by a magnetic or conductance locator.
C. Multiple-family dwellings shall have one (1) curb stop located within the public right-of-way as determined by the city, which shall provide shutoff service to the entire facility.
D. No person shall deposit any dirt or other material on or in any public curb box, valve box, or tamper in any way to prevent the use of such by the City or its agents.
E. No person shall park any vehicle, or otherwise block access to a curb stop for the purpose of prevention of shutting, opening, or any other use of the curb stop. Persons refusing to move vehicles may be subjected to towing at the owner’s cost.
