

ORDINANCE NO. 1032

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 12.04.070(I) and (K) PERTAINING TO THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas (City) Council finds and determines that the following changes and clarifications need to be made in regard to the City of Douglas Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, consideration has been given to ensure fairness to all City of Douglas residents and make new regulations reasonable.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, WYOMING:

Section 1. Section 12.04.070(I) and (K) of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.04 – Excavations and Obstructions of Streets and Sidewalks

12.04.070 - Performance of work.

All work performed pursuant to the issuance of an excavation permit shall be done as follows:

- I. Where excavations occur in unpaved surfaces, the area shall be restored by placing a minimum of four (4) inches of stabilized gravel on the surface of the excavation.

- K. As a condition of the permit, the applicant shall guarantee his work for a period of one (1) year from the date of final completion of the work. If settlement equal to or greater than one-half (½) inch or pavement separation equal to or greater than one-quarter (¼) inch occurs at the site of the excavation, or immediately adjacent thereto, at any time within one (1) year from the date of final completion of the original restoration, the applicant shall be responsible for repairing such settled or separated areas in accordance with the directions of the public works director or city engineer. If potholes, ruts, and/or other surface defects greater than one (1) inch occur in dirt alleys, or immediately adjacent thereto, at any time within one (1) year from the date of final completion of the original restoration, the applicant shall be responsible for repairing such settled or separated areas in accordance with the directions of the public works director or city engineer.
